## Utah State History Announces Grant Awards to Communities

Utah State History has awarded more than \$100,000 in matching grants to 21 Certified Local Governments (CLGs) for the 2009-2010 grant year. For more information on the Certified Local Government Program, please visit <http://history.utah.gov>.

The following cities and counties received grants:

**Beaver - \$3,000** for repairs on the National Register-listed Beaver Public Library.

**Ephraim - \$4,300** for repairs on the National Register-listed Ephraim Co-op Building.

**Farmington - \$3,000** to hire a professional consultant to complete intensive level survey documentation on 8 to 11 historic buildings.

**Gunnison - \$7,000** for repairs on the National Register-listed Casino Star Theatre.

**Kanab - \$7,661** for exterior painting on the National Register-listed Kanab Heritage House, to hire a professional consultant to prepare a National Register nomination for the historic Kanab Post Office, purchase historic markers, and update and print Kanab's historic sites walking brochure.

**Logan - \$3,000** to purchase and install approximately 10 historic markers.

**Manti - \$3,000** for repairs and sign construction on the National Register-listed Manti City Hall.

**Mapleton - \$1,400** to publish a booklet of historic buildings and their history.

**Mendon - \$1,000** for exterior painting on the National Register-listed William and Elizabeth Barrett Farmstead.

**Midway - \$2,500** to hire a professional consultant to update the 1984 reconnaissance level survey.

**Mt. Pleasant - \$5,000** to hire a professional consultant to prepare a multiple property submission and National Register nominations for 7 to 8 historic buildings.

**Murray - \$8,500** to conduct a reconnaissance level survey for approximately 1,200 buildings.

**Ogden - \$17,000** to prepare a National Register nomination for the Berthana Building, update kiosks along 25<sup>th</sup> Street, update and print walking tour brochures for Historic 25th Street, Eccles Avenue District, and Jefferson Avenue District, attend the 2009 Utah Preservation Conference, and other preservation planning activities.

**Parowan - \$4,881** for repairs on the National Register-listed Meeks/Green Farmstead.

**Rockville - \$3,000** to prepare a National Register nomination for Grafton Historic District and repairs to the Russell home in Grafton.

**Sandy - \$3,000** for new awnings on the National Register-listed Sandy Co-op Block, and to hire a professional consultant to complete intensive level survey documentation on the Old Valley High School Building.

**Sanpete County - \$5,000** to hire a licensed architect to prepare a preservation plan for restoring the historic Mt. Pleasant Carnegie Library.

**Santa Clara - \$3,300** to purchase and install 5 historic markers.

**South Jordan - \$6,000** to re-roof the National Register-listed Samuel Holt Farmstead.

**Spring City - \$4,950** to hire a licensed architect to provide design services for the National Register listed Spring City School.

**Springville - \$6,600** for repairs on the National Register-listed Springville Carnegie Library, to hire a professional consultant to complete intensive level survey documentation on 3 historic buildings, and website updates and maintenance.
